- Establish a simple pathway for all Tasmanians, including public housing tenants and applicants to build their own homes and communities, under builder's supervision, gaining significant equity in their new rent-to-own houses as well as skills and income potential.
- First-home-owner grants carefully targeted to result in better homes and stronger communities, not just increased prices as has been the case. Enable owner-builder finance.
- Adopt successful European models of affordable and guaranteed lifetime rental housing, cohousing and cooperative housing, with a sense of ownership and security.
- No to the current stadium proposal. Renovate an existing stadium, or build a new one where it will be cheaper to construct, fit better the scale of surrounding development and bring more benefit to its immediate community, who actually wants it there.
- Balance the budget with realistic spending and no unnecessary debt. Healthcare housing education everything else.
- Work towards merit-based free university and TAFE for diligent students and value-based education debt waivers, e.g. for doctors, nurses or teachers working in Tasmania.
- Support local production, resource processing and manufacturing. Revive traditional industries, such as boot making or furniture manufacture. **Grow "Made in Tasmania" brand**.
